

Jože Trontelj

Some institutions (including Slovenian Academy of Sciences and Arts for which Trontelj was President at the time of his death) are planning to rename Institute of Ethics, co-founded by Trontelj to the Institute of Jože Trontelj - Institute for Ethics and Values.

One way to honor our friend Jože is to support the Institute economically.

In this context we have the following facts about the formal status of Institute:

1. The Institute was founded by the Slovene Academy of Sciences and Art and Prof Dr Jože Trontelj, Prof Dr Janek Musek and Marijan Musek, Director, Institute for Ethics. The Institute is free standing and independent in its activities as well as to provide funding for its work (we don't receive state funds). So far we operate by supporting renowned Slovenian and international companies that recognize the importance of our efforts for a stable society of the future.
2. The Institute is a non-profit organization and is under Slovenian law entitled to receive grants, so that received donations are not taxed. The Institute operates only through one bank account.
3. After consulting with our accountant, the easiest way to transfer donations to the bank account with a mark "donation".
